The program will begin on Wednesday 26th October at 4.00pm with a meeting in the quad for a welcome and overview. Transport to and from Wyong High School will need to be organised by each parent/caregiver with each Wednesday afternoon concluding at 5.30pm. Please note that some activities have limited spaces or minimum registration requirements. If you have selected an activity that has reached capacity, you will be contacted to arrange an alternate activity.

During this 4 week program, students will experience a range of subjects including Agriculture, AVID, English, PDHPE, Creative and Performing Arts, Human Society and Its Environment, Information Technology, Mathematics, STEM (Science Technology Engineering and Maths), Technology and Applied Studies and Science. Students will participate in engaging activities that will encourage them to become familiar with the school and the learning opportunities offered at Wyong High School.

It looks like an ordinary, two-dimensional, paper hexagon with a front and a back, but hidden inside are four more <i>sides (or faces)</i> that become visible by flexing the paper.

Pencil Code uses visual blocks and various programming languages to introduce and develop basic programming concepts through drawing art, playing music, and creating games- come and check it out!
